Warning: This Auger Extension is heavy, and using it creates multiple pinch points that can cause serious injury, including dismemberment and death. Use safe lifting practices and caution when connecting this Auger Extension to the auger drive motor and to an auger bit.

Always maintain a safe distance from the Auger Extension, keeping hands, arms, legs, feet, and hair clear of the Auger Extension and other rotating parts.

Safety starts with the operator, be alert and aware of your surroundings. Be familiar with your equipment, know how to stop the tractor, auger, and Auger Extension should someone, especially children, or animals come into your operating area. Also know how to reverse the auger and Auger Extension should it strike or become entangled with an underground obstruction. If, after all necessary precautions have been taken an underground utility is contacted, immediately stop the machine, call 911 and the utility provider. If it was an electrical line strike, warn others not to approach the area, stay on the machine until you have been assured by the utility provider that the power has been disconnected to the struck line. In the event of an electrical fire, jump clear of the machine with both feet and legs together and hop away, or shuffle your feet for at least 50 feet. In the event of a gas line strike, again warn others to stay away and after turning off the machine walk to a safe location and await emergency personnel.

Always follow your companies, cities or counties safe operating guidelines regarding safe auger use and excavation practices.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator. If there is any doubt as to the operation or safety of the equipment, DO NOT USE!!! CALL A TOOL SHED IMMEDIATELY!!! FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN INJURY OR DEATH
