- 3. Do not wear loose clothing or jewelry. Wear safety glasses, ear protection, & dust mask if needed.
- 4. Always inspect tool for frayed or damaged cords. Do not use if band saw is not in proper working order.
- 5. Avoid accidental starting. Do not carry plugged in tool with finger on switch. Be sure the switch is in the "OFF" position before plugging into outlet.
- 6. Never connect a band saw to any source that does not match the voltage of the tool.
- 7. Do not force the band saw. Do not bear down while cutting. Only use for the purpose it was intended.
- 8. Keep the blade off the workpiece until the motor has reached the selected speed.
